SUBJECT: Toy & Hobby Share



OBJECTIVE -- For Boys and Girls to Learn How to Speak Effectively Before a Group Conveying New and Interesting Information.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. The 4-H'er must display his or her toy or tools, craft supplies, or finished product related to his or her hobby.
2. No live animals may be used as part of display.
3. Talks must be related to the hobby or toy.
4. Talks can run from one (1) to seven (7) minutes in length.
5. Any boy or girl enrolled in 4-H may enter.
6. There will be three age categories: PIL (5-8), participation ONLY, *JR.(9-13), SR.(14-19). Age eligibility is established as of January 1, 2003. **The JR. Division may be split depending upon the number of entries in each age.*
7. Scholarship awards will be given in JR. and SR. categories only:
 - 1st place - \$25.00 scholarship or \$50.00 savings bond
 - 2nd place - \$15.00 scholarship
 - 3rd place - \$10.00 scholarship
8. There will be no competition beyond the County level.
9. Talks must be written by the participants. (Boys and girls are encouraged, however, to receive help from parents, teachers, leaders, etc.) Child's name, age and toy or hobby, or any facts the 4-H'er thinks might be of interest to the audience should be included.
10. Contest will be held on Monday, January 27, 2003, 7:00 pm at the Sampson County Livestock Facility, 421 South of Clinton - towards Wilmington. After four lanes turns into two lanes, the Facility will be 1/4 of a mile on the right.
